2. Format of the oral examination

To give a **2-minute individual presentation** based on a given situation provided on the examination question paper.

3. Examination Procedures

- (i) Students must report to the teacher-in-charge / person-in-charge in the **Waiting Room** (Room No. 215) **15 minutes earlier** than the examination time assigned to the group they belong to. Students who arrive late will have a 1 mark penalty imposed.
- (ii) Students will be directed to the respective examination rooms.
- (iii) Once students are instructed to enter the examination room, they should read the “Instructions to Students” which can be found on the desk.
- (iv) Students must not turn over their examination paper until told to do so.
- (v) Students will have **3 minutes to prepare for the examination.** Students can make notes on the note sheet provided during the preparation time.
- (vi) Students must not write on the examination paper.
- (vii) Students will have **2 minutes to present their talk.**
- (viii) The examiners will show a card to indicate there are “30 seconds left”.
- (ix) After the talk, students should give the examination paper and note sheet to the examiner.

4. Students are reminded **to bring along a pen for the examination.**

5. Students are required to stay until the end of the session. Then they may leave. No student is to stay back in school to play ball games.

6. Students must keep quiet while waiting for their examination.

7. No make-up examination will be given to absentees. Latecomers will be subjected to a mark penalty.
